Main Text

- **Introduction**

- **Case report or clinical series**

The case introduction should clearly state the necessary details of the course of the disease, and include the patient's onset, development, outcome, and follow-up results. Avoid copying the original medical records and avoid using various non-objective, doubtful or speculative statements. Since the case report is a rare or special case, the symptoms, signs, examination results, and treatment methods of special significance should be described in detail to highlight the key points.

- **Discussion**

The discussion should incorporate the significance of the new information and relevance of the novel findings in light of existing knowledge. Limitations should also be stated.

- **Conclusions**

This section should only summarize what you have said in the main text of the paper. You can make suggestions for further research or call for action, but you should not introduce any new evidence or facts into the conclusion.
